Section I - Legislative Intent:

The purpose of this Local Law is to promote and protect the public health, welfare and safety by regulating the use of pleasure vessels operated on Brantingham Lake. It is further intended to protect property values, eliminate noise pollution, enhance and protect the physical appearance of the community, preserve the scenic and natural beauty of designated areas, reduce accidents, reduce hazards created by high speeds, and improve the overall community environment.

Section II - Definitions:

A) Brantingham Lake: All references to Brantingham Lake herein shall include the connected body of water that is known locally as "The Lily Pond".

Section III - Regulation of Pleasure Vessels:

A) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Local Law, or any inconsistent local laws, every pleasure vessel operated on Brantingham Lake, located in the Town of Greig, Lewis County, shall be operated in a careful and prudent manner, in such a way as not to unreasonably interfere with or endanger any property, vessel, person, or wildlife.

B) No vessel shall operate at a speed that exceeds forty five (45) miles per hour (MPH) [and ten (10) MPH in the Lily Pond]. From the time between one-half hour after sunset until one-half hour before sunrise, no vessel shall operate at a speed that exceeds twenty (20) MPH (and five (5) MPH in the Lily Pond). In the channel between Dark Island and Red Pine Point no vessel shall operate at a speed that exceeds twenty-five (25) MPH.

C) No person shall ride on water skis, kneeboard, tube, or similar item on the waters of Brantingham Lake without wearing a serviceable personal flotation device (i.e. life belt, life preserver, etc.) approved by the United States Coast Guard for a person of their size. This provision will not apply to a paid performer engaged in a professional exhibition.

D) No person shall ride on a motorized jet ski or similar motorized personal watercraft on the waters of Brantingham Lake within two hundred (200) feet of shore. The allowed exceptions

are: leaving and returning to their point of origin, the channel between Dark Island and Red Pine Point, and the channel between Brantingham Lake and the Lily Pond, also with exception of leaving and returning to shore with water skier in tow.

Section IV - Exceptions:

The provisions of Section III shall not apply to any vessel competing in or practicing for a race that has written authorization by the Town Board of the Town of Greig, on a specified course. To apply for such authorization, a written notice of the time, conditions and location of the race shall be submitted at least sixty (60) days in advance, to the Town of Greig Board, so that sufficient public notice and a public hearing may be held.

Section V - Regulation of Aircraft and Ultra Lights:

Any aircraft, including Federal Aviation Agency licensed aircraft and ultralights: (a) shall be excluded from the speed limit provisions of Section III B of this Local Law, and (b) shall not land or take off from Brantingham Lake from the time between one-half hour after sunset until one-half hour before sunrise, and (c) shall not land or take off from the Lily Pond at any time. All persons in an ultralight aircraft while on Brantingham Lake are required to meet the provisions of Section III C of this Local Law.

Section VI - Penalties:

Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of this Local Law shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the first offense. For a second offense within twenty four months, he shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00). For a third or subsequent offense within twenty four months, he shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

Section VII - Severability:

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate

the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment will have been rendered.

Section VIII - Effective Date:

This Local Law should take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
